

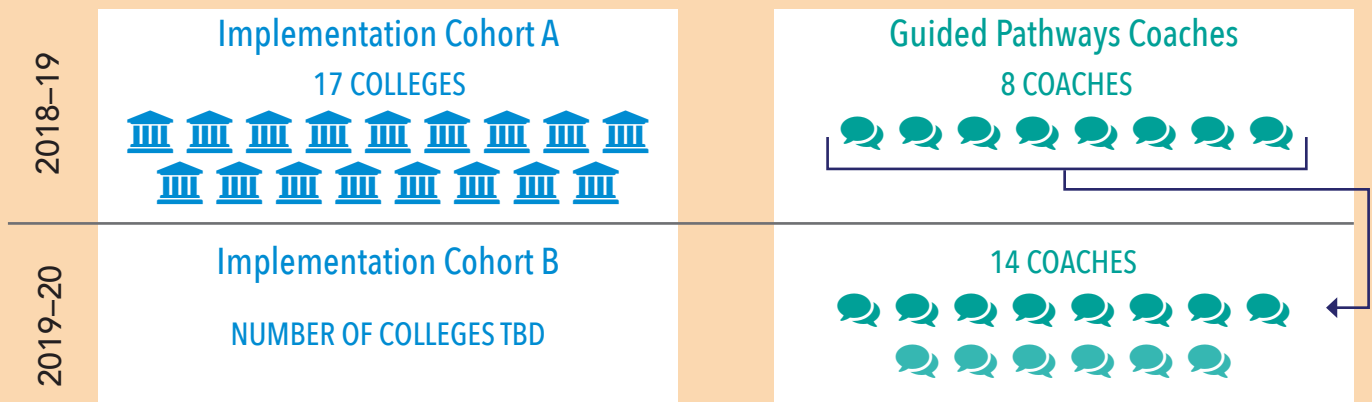
NORTH CAROLINA Student Success Center: ALL IN

The North Carolina Student Success Center (NCSSC) supports the state's 58 community colleges with services that address guided pathways planning and implementation. Colleges are undertaking this work to improve rates of college completion, transfer, and attainment of jobs with value in the labor market—and to achieve equity in those outcomes.

NCSSC gives each college support based on its current needs and goals. In addition, the Center developed a coaching model that provides guided pathways coaches, who support colleges in each of the state's three regions.
